

British Indoor Grand Prix Series 2010

Competition Rules

1. General

Applicable Rules

- 1.1 The British Indoor Grand Prix Series 2010 Events (the “Events”) adopt and apply Book IV of the International Ski Competition Rules (Edition 2008 as amended by the November 2009 Precisions) issued by the International Ski Federation (“ICR”), as amended by Book 1 and Book VI of the British Competition Rules (December 2009) issued by Snowsport GB (“BCR”), save as amended below (the “Rules”).

Seeding

- 1.2 Seeding applied to the Events is the British Indoor Seeding System (“BISS”) whereby the seed points are calculated as follows from the Events and Events of the last year:

Result	Race points + race penalty points
Basic Points	The end of season points from the last year
Seed Points	The minimum of Basic Points, average of the best 2 results from the current year, average of the best results and the Basic Points

- 1.3 If a competitor has no BISS points but has points on the BASS list current at the time of the closing date for entry to any relevant race in the Events (the “Race”), then they may apply to the organisers by notice in writing, at least 7 days before the Race, for a conversion of such points (the formulae to be determined by the organisers). Such converted points will apply to the criteria for acceptance to the Race and the Race start order only but will not constitute actual BISS points for purposes of seeding nor in the calculation of the Race penalty point.

Ski Lengths

- 1.4 The British Artificial Competition Rules issued by Snowsport GB (“BACR”) do not apply to the Events. The relevant rules in BCR Book VI concerning competition equipment require the following minimum ski lengths for the slalom races at the Events:

Men	165 cm [subject to a tolerance of 10 cm for <i>Junior 1 competitors only</i>]
Ladies	155 cm <i>with no tolerance</i>
Children 2	130 cm <i>with no tolerance</i>
Children 1	130 cm <i>with no tolerance</i>
Note	The ski length <i>must</i> be marked on the ski

2. Amendments

- 2.1 Due to the nature and extent of the Events and the indoor slope environment, although the Events should be regarded as “snow” races rather than “artificial” races, it is not necessary or appropriate to incorporate every aspect of the ICR and the BCR in to the Rules.
- 2.2 Adopting the paragraph numbers in ICR Book IV and the amendments thereto in the relevant paragraphs of BCR Book I, the following ICR and BCR rules apply or are amended as set out below:

- 621.11.2 Applies save that 30 places is substituted by 15 places and the order amended accordingly. Minis do not have seed points and will be drawn and start as a separate group

- 623.2 Applies, save that 623.2.7 is not applicable
- 623.3 Applies
- 627 Applies only in so far as a competitor may not be permitted to start if he violates the competition equipment requirements in BCR Book VI, as incorporated by paragraph 2.3 below. At the discretion of the jury such a competitor may be cautioned and allowed to race but any results from such race will not qualify for seeding nor will such a competitor be allocated a valid finish in the published results
- 628.3 Applies in so far as the competitor does not wear or carry the official start number

- 628.5 Applies in so far as the competitor is not ready to start on time or makes a false start
- 628.8 Applies in so far as the competitor continues to race after committing a gate fault
- 628.9 Applies in so far as the competitor fails to pass the finish correctly

- 640 Applies save that all jury decisions are final

- 801.1 The vertical drop of the course will be determined by the choice of the ski slope
- 801.2 Applies save that (1) the number of gates (2) the distances (3) the changes of direction (4) and the requirement for a gate to consist of 2 poles will be determined by the length of the course and the characteristics of the slope
- 803.1 Applies save that reference to the 30 first competitors is substituted by reference to the first 15 competitors
- 803.2 Applies save that the requirements for hairpin combinations and delayed turns and the stated distances as set out therein and in 803.2.1 may not be applicable, at the discretion of the Course Setters

804 Applies in that the single pole slalom may be adopted without restriction as therein mentioned, depending upon the length of the course and the characteristics of the slope

805 Applies save that warnings will be issued in the English language (unless the competitor does not understand the same) and a competitor must be ready to enter the start gate as soon as the competitor before him has started

806 Applies save for 806.3 which is not applicable

2.3 BCR Book VI is adopted save that the relevant references therein are those applicable to slalom only, as highlighted at paragraph 1.4 above.
